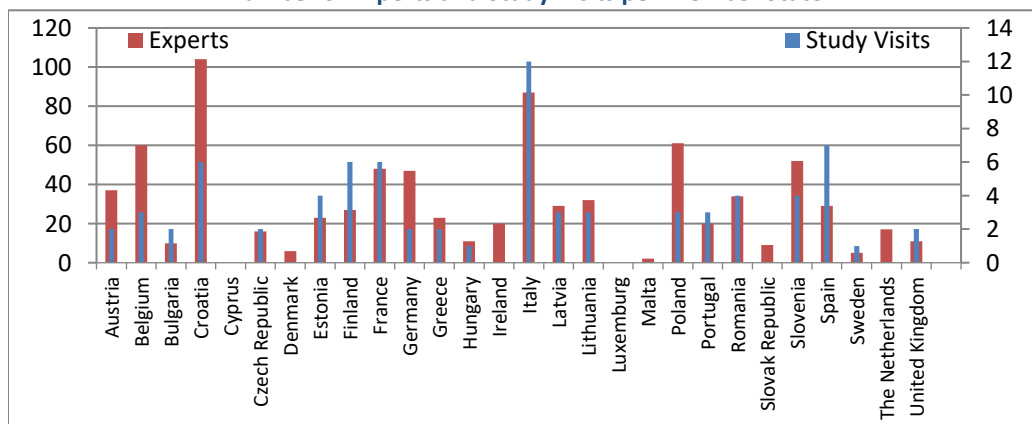

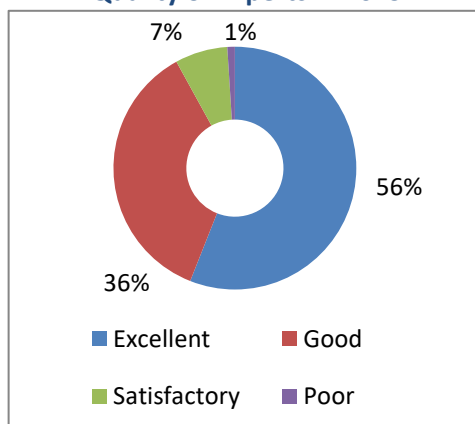

### Number of Experts and Study Visits per Member State

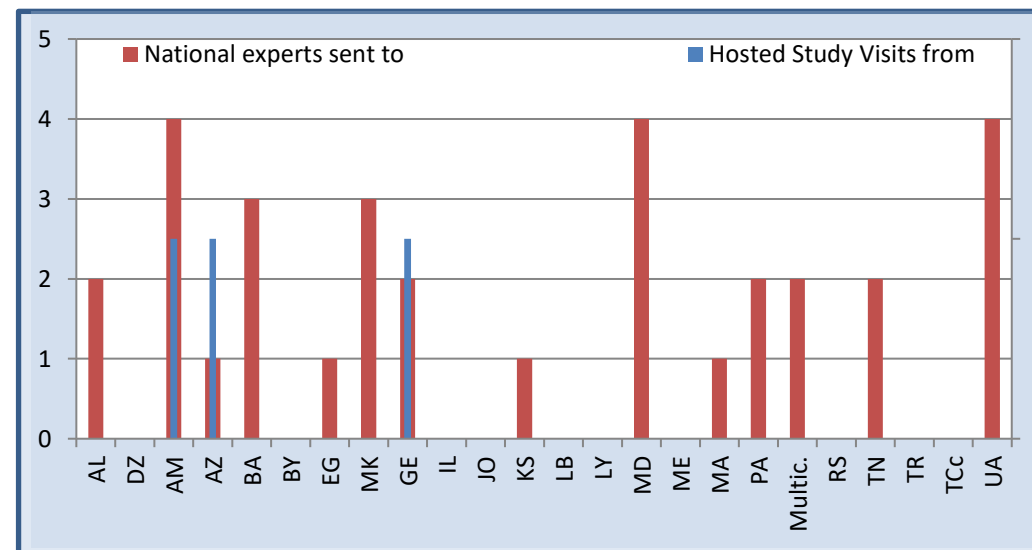
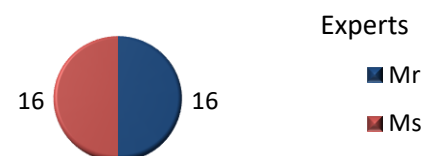


### Quality of Experts in 2019
